#### Tues, August 29 DEPART THE UNITED STATES

#### Wed, August 30 SHANNON ARRIVAL

After landing at Shannon Airport, complete customs and immigration formalities. Your CIE Tours driver/guide will welcome you to Ireland and escort you and your luggage to the coach. Next, journey into Bunratty and stop to visit the Bunratty Folk Park, which comprises a collection of farmhouses from different regions of Ireland. Also, see a 19th century village street with a pub, school, general store and many other buildings where traditional lifestyles and crafts are demonstrated. Motor a short distance to your hotel, check in and enjoy some free time before this evening's festivities.

Tonight, join in the fun and feasting at Bunratty Castle. Your medieval-style banquet is served in the Great Hall of the 15th century castle.

#### Thu, August 31 CLIFFS OF MOHER
