OUTLINE ITINERARY

MON, JUN 12- UNITED STATES TO SHANNON

Depart your hometown and take an overnight flight across the Atlantic.

TUE, JUN 13- SHANNON ARRIVAL & BUNRATTY FOLK PARK

Your CIE Tours driver/guide will welcome you to Ireland and take you to your motorcoach. Drive a short distance to the village of Bunratty and visit Bunratty Folk Park, which comprises a collection of farmhouses from different regions of Ireland and a 19th century village street. Then check into your hotel, where you will have some free time in the afternoon. This evening join in the fun and feasting at Bunratty or Knappogue Castle. Your medieval-style banquet is served in the Great Hall of the 15th century castle.

WED, JUN 14- CLIFFS OF MOHER & GALWAY PANORAMIC

Depart Bunratty and drive along the coastline of County Clare to view the Cliffs of Moher, one of the country's most magnificent rock formations that rise to heights of almost 700 feet above the churning Atlantic swells. Pass through the Burren Country, an area of rocky limestone hills where a number of unique flowers thrive. Continue north to Galway and embark on a panoramic tour of the city. Then check into your hotel and enjoy the remainder of the afternoon at leisure. In the evening join your fellow travelers for dinner in the hotel.

THU, JUN 15- CRUISE ON LOUGH CORRIB & CONNEMARA

This morning embark on a cruise on Lough Corrib, which is the largest lake in the Republic of Ireland. Disembark your cruise on the grounds of the historic Ashford Castle Gardens, which dates from the 13th century. Enjoy some free time in Cong village where the iconic movie, "The Quiet Man" was filmed in 1951. Then drive a short distance to Eddie's of Clonbur and enjoy a drink and lunch with your group. After lunch tour Connemara and admire the sweeping views of boglands and misty mountains. Return to Galway to sightsee, shop and dine on your own.

FRI, JUN 16- DINGLE

Depart Galway and drive around the shores of Galway Bay and past the rounded limestone hills of the Burren country. Stop in Tralee for coffee at a local venue. Then continue your journey into Dingle and check into your hotel for dinner and an overnight stay.

SAT, JUN 17- DINGLE PENINSULA TOUR

Today discover the beauties of the Dingle Peninsula, made famous by David Lean's movie, "Ryan's Daughter." Drive along the south shore of the peninsula for plenty of vistas of heathery mountains, sandy stretches of beach and rocky headlands. There will be frequent stops at strategic locations to admire the views and take photos. Continue your drive on to the western tip of the peninsula. Return to Dingle in time for dinner.

SUN, JUN 18- KILLARNEY & KINSALE

After breakfast travel just outside of Killarney to the Gap of Dunloe to

visit Moriarty's Gift Shop. Opened in 1964 by Michael and Margaret Moriarty, today it's a landmark destination for all shoppers. Then enjoy some free time in Killarney to sightsee, shop and have an independent lunch. Then enjoy some of the highlights of the famous Ring of Kerry, considered one of the finest scenic drives in the world. As you head for the coastal town of Kinsale, a popular yachting center and attractive town with brightly painted houses and quaint narrow streets. Upon arrival check into your waterfront hotel and freshen up before dinner with your group.

MON, JUN 19- BLARNEY CASTLE & WOOLLEN MILLS

This morning drive a short distance to Blarney to climb to the battlements of Blarney Castle to kiss the famous "Stone of Eloquence." Also visit the Blarney Woollen Mills, which has an excellent range of Irish products of all types. Head back to Kinsale, where the evening is free for individual pursuits and dining.

TUE, JUN 20- KINSALE TO DUBLIN

Depart Kinsale today and travel northeast to Dublin. Drive through the midland region where you will see many farms and marketing towns. Your route will take you past the towns of Portlaoise and Kildare and into the metropolitan area of Dublin. Upon arrival check into your hotel and freshen up before tonight's festivities. This evening drive to Taylors Three Rock for dinner followed by a lively show of traditional Irish songs, dancing and music.

WED, JUN 21- HOP ON HOP OFF DUBLIN

Enjoy the day at leisure in Dublin, where you can choose from a wide variety of pursuits. Use your Hop on Hop off pass to visit a number of places. Using your vouchers you may either visit the Guinness Storehouse or Old Jameson Distillery for a tour and a sample of the finished product. There are also plenty of museums, shops and pubs you may visit.

THU, JUN 22- RETURN TO THE UNITED STATES

Transfer to Dublin Airport in good time to check in for your flight. You may do some last minute shopping at the duty free stores before boarding your aircraft and flying across the Atlantic Ocean back to the United States.
